Governor Bruce Rauner of **Illinois** has signed a <u>law</u> requiring public schools to allow parents to administer medical marijuana at school to eligible children.

Michigan court <u>passed a ruling</u> that bans 'wet cannabis,' a phase all cannabis must go through before it can be consumed.

A petition to get <u>State Question 797</u> to be put up for a vote on the Nov. 6 ballot has compiled enough signatures. The signatures must be verified by the **Oklahoma** Secretary of State's Office, and a review must be conducted before the question can go on the ballot.

Maine has made <u>significant amendments</u> to its medical marijuana law, including a measure providing a deduction for medical marijuana-related business expenses otherwise prohibited by federal tax law.

A **Pennsylvania** lawmaker has announced he plans to introduce a legislation to legalize the sale of recreational marijuana.

A strong bi-partisan bill, <u>AJR27</u>, passed on August 27, urging the United States Department of Justice not to direct its enforcement priorities towards **California's** lawfully and closely regulated cannabis industry.

AB1741 was approved by the **California** Governor. This bill, until January 1, 2022, would authorize a person licensed under MAUCRSA, whose estimated tax liability under that law averages \$10,000 or more per month, to remit amounts due by a means other than electronic funds transfer if the board deems it necessary to facilitate the collection of amounts due.
