The general assembly of Connecticut has introduced an act authorizing and taxing the retail sale of marijuana. Introduced by Rep. Albis of the 99th District, HB05111 coincides with HB05112, which would permit the utilization of the retail taxation to fund substance abuse treatment, prevention, education and awareness programs.

A slightly bipartisan-backed resolution has been introduced, requesting Congress to consider legislation to de-schedule marijuana or otherwise allow the states and territories of the United States to determine for themselves the best means of regulating marijuana.
