# January 10th

**Nebraska** bill <u>LB110</u> has been filed and the Judiciary Committee will hold a hearing for LB110, the Adopt the Medical Cannabis Act, on Jan. 25.

### January 16th

**Alaska** bill <u>SB8</u> has been introduced to legislation regarding access to Marijuana conviction records to reduce barriers to employment for people who have been convicted of low-level marijuana possession crimes that would be legal under today's laws.

## January 23rd

**California** bill <u>SB153</u> was introduced, Wilk. Industrial hemp and existing law governs the growth of industrial hemp and establishes a registration program for growers of industrial hemp and seed breeders. Existing law defines various terms for the purposes of these provisions.This bill would make non substantive changes to those definitions.

# January 24th

**Iowa** bill <u>SF104</u> an act relating to the compassionate use of medical cannabis Act, reclassifying marijuana, including tetrahydrocannabinols, from a schedule I controlled substance to a schedule II controlled substance, providing for civil and criminal penalties and fees, and including effective date provisions.



#### January 29th

**Wyoming** bill <u>HB0278</u> of Medical Cannabis Act was introduced and would legalize the use of medical marijuana in Wyoming has been introduced in the state Legislature.

#### January 31st

**Tennessee** bill <u>SB0260</u> As introduced, declares that a person who holds a valid medical marijuana patient identification card issued by another state does not commit an offense in this state if the person possesses, or distributes to another cardholder, marijuana not in excess of one-half ounce.
