With almost 200 active cannabis-related bills, tracking legislation can be daunting. That's why we're introducing the BioTrackTHC Marijuana Legislation Roundup – a quick roundup of all the current marijuana-related legislative progress being made in each state. Something we missed? Florida

A new bill to allow smoking cannabis for medical use was introduced in Florida. Under the current regulations dictated by Amendment 2- combusting cannabis is illegal. <u>SB 726</u> was introduced by Democratic Senator Gary Farmer.

Maine

Maine's cannabis legalization efforts took a blow this week when Governor LePage again vetoed an implementation bill. <u>Citing fear of federal intervention</u>, LePage will now hope that the veto is not overridden by a majority vote.

Oklahoma

Oklahoma may vote on medical cannabis as early as June 2018. There are rumors that <u>Governor Mary Fallin might move to hold the vote for SQ788</u> before the general election but it is yet to be determined how that may impact voter turnout and initiative outcome.

Federal

In federal news, the House's <u>Industrial Hemp Farming Act</u> received 2 new co-sponsors. Mike Coffman (R-Co) and Dwight Evans (D-Pa) bring the total to 33 supporters.
